Project Summary

The Lake Champlain Maritime Museum and the Rouses Point-Champlain Historical Society partnered to bring the Lois McClure to Rouses Point in the summer of 2009 as part of the Quadricentennial celebrations in the Village. This was the first visit by the replica canal schooner visited the northern most point of Lake Champlain in New York State.

The vessel was the centerpiece of a two-day celebration that included music, food and a theatrical presentation by a group of Quebec performers. More than 700 visitors boarded the boat during its two-day stay at Rouses Point.
