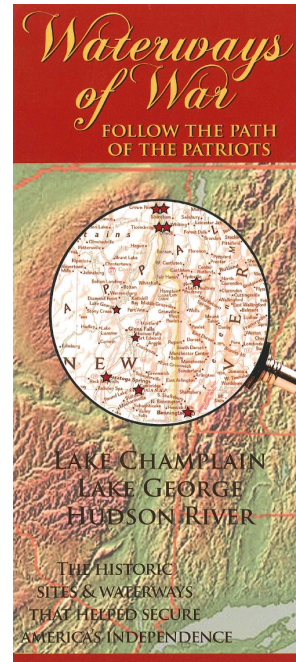

Project Summary

Fort Ticonderoga utilized a 2008 Champlain Valley National Heritage Partnership Implementation Grant to develop a promotional “rack card” for *Waterways of War: Military Heritage of the Champlain Valley* that links heritage sites in the Champlain Valley sites and the NYS Military History Museum in a single effort to focus visitors’ and residents’ attention on the importance of the regional bodies of water; Lake Champlain, Lake George and the Hudson River. Understanding that they were vital to the history of Vermont and New York and continue to play a vital part in the economy and ecology here will foster an appreciation of the need to conserve them.
