Project Summary

The Champlain Valley National Heritage Partnership (CVNHP) provided a \$3,000 Education and Outreach Grant to Fort Ticonderoga to focus on the French & Indian War and the French soldiers who served in the area. Visitors witnessed interpreters making their extensively researched uniforms, demonstrating one of the most common trades of the 18th century. Guests made connections between themselves and the soldiers of the 18th century, while learning about the military and cultural history of Fort Ticonderoga. In addition, Fort Ticonderoga’s website designer completed a number of pages of French content accessible on the regular website and on mobile devices.
