## **Project Summary**

The Champlain Valley National Heritage Partnership (CVNHP) provided a \$3,000 Education and Outreach Grant to Fort Ticonderoga to focus on the French & Indian War and the French soldiers who served in the area. Visitors witnessed interpreters making their extensively researched uniforms, demonstrating one of the most common trades of the 18<sup>th</sup> century. Guests made connections between themselves and the soldiers of the 18<sup>th</sup> century, while learning about the military and cultural history of Fort Ticonderoga. In addition, Fort Ticonderoga's website designer completed a number of pages of French content accessible on the regular website and on mobile devices.
