The CVNHP-funded project is a diorama within a permanent exhibit room regarding the legacy of Georgia O’Keeffe and Alfred Stieglitz’s crucial years as summer residents in our region; an interpretation of the role that the town and region played in their lives and art during those decades. The project created a diorama of the artists’ summer homes and studios one mile north of Lake George Village, down the main street circa 1918-1938 as an interactive, historically interpretive folk art experience.
