#### Project Summary

Students from Burr and Burton Academy in Manchester connected with the region’s history through a CVNHP Local Heritage Grant. Students interviewed and filmed residents—including a 104-year-old former Burr and Burton student, a local poet, a veteran of the German Army who fought in World War II, and various tradespeople from the greater Manchester region including the towns of Dorset, Pawlet, Rupert, Londonderry and Peru. 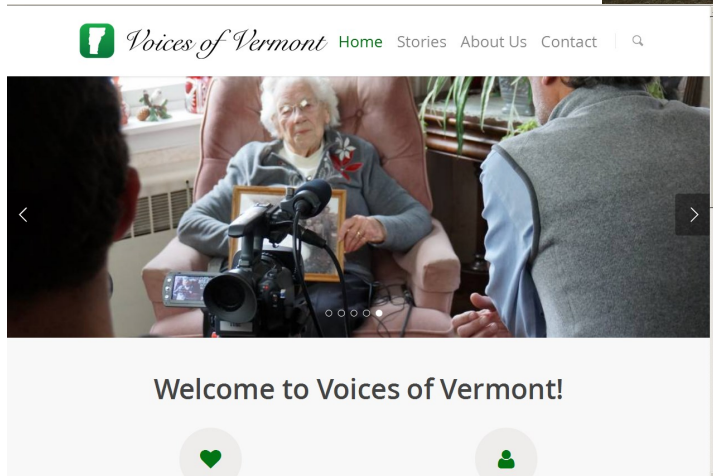
